#### Mission




- Promoting a high-quality standards in the manufacture of weighing instruments;
- Co-operating with the metrological services in the establishment and amendment of the regulatory environment;
- Reducing the technical and administrative regulations relevant to weighing instruments to those requirements which are necessary not to harm users;
- Ensuring harmonisation of national regulations and the use of established international standards, in order to eliminate barriers to cross-border trade of weighing instruments;
- Ensuring that national and international requirements do not prevent the development of new weighing technologies;
- Liaising with national and international organisations and with end users concerning all aspects of legal metrology including consistent interpretation of requirements;
- Promoting a good understanding of modern weighing technology, especially in developing countries;
- Ensuring fair trade practices by all weighing instrument manufacturers worldwide.

#### Activities Business & Trade Group



- Organising events (online and physical) to increase the visibility of the industry and support the advocacy
  - E.g. breakfast in European Parliament or dinner event with Member State authorities
- Collecting industry data to estimate trends
- Initiate activities to increase harmonisation in areas such as reverification to remove barriers to trade within the weighing industry






#### Activities Business & Trade Group



- Support activities to improve market surveillance within the weighing industry and reduce unfair competition
- Discussing key trends and problems within the industry and work on solutions
  - E.g. long type-approval procedures causing problems with supply chain delays
- Setting-up the 'World with Weighing' campaign and 'Weighing you can trust' campaign to make users and buyers more aware of the importance of quality weighing





## Activities legal metrology group



- Representing the weighing industry at WELMEC, OIML and European commission meetings
  - Defending the interest of the industry and updating members about discussions
- Providing input to legislation, standards, recommendations and guides being developed to make them practical and avoid disproportionate requirements
  - E.g. OIML R76 on NAWI's, the evaluation of the EU legislation (MID and NAWID), WELMEC guide 7.2 on software
- Sharing information on developments in different countries
  - E.g. how to access the UK market after Brexit, German prepackage legislation



## Activities legal metrology group



- Technical database with legal metrology information from many EU countries and International Partner Organisations to ease access to information for all members
- Regular overview of developments on all relevant EU legislation to allow members to be prepared for changes
  - E.g. Machinery Regulation or chemical policy

## Membership options



#### Associations:

- Weighing industry associations can join and their fee is set based on calculations taking into account the size of the market and association
  - There is a minimum fee of 2,500 euro
- Weighing instrument manufacturers:
  - Manufacturers that are based in a country where there is no weighing industry association can become full or associated member
    - Full member: All benefits (including working group participation)
      - Fee: 2,500 euro
    - Association member: Most benefits, but no working group participation and no voting rights at GA
      - Fee: 750 euro
- Companies not being manufacturer or service provider in the weighing industry
  - Only associated membership: Most benefits except working group participation and fee of 750 euro
